If you would like to take part, you will need to bring –

- a canvas or jute bag (£1.50 from Sainsburys). Unpick it and remove all lose threads.
- 80 cm (115cm wide) strong fabric for outside, [curtain material is ideal, offcuts available from Chelfords, Coldharbour Lane, Harpenden]
- 80 cm (115 cm wide) fabric for inside, [curtain lining or cotton]
- thread to match fabric, sewing kit including **strong** hand sewing needle and thread, fabric scissors, pins, quilt clips.
- sewing machine with ¼" foot if possible, 2 machine needles size 90. [If you cannot bring your machine, there will be some available to use]



Book/gadget evening: bring a sewing book that you love or a useful gadget or one that you don't know how to use to share with fellow members.
