If you would like to take part, you will need to bring -

- a canvas or jute bag (£1.50 from Sainsburys).
 Unpick it and remove all lose threads.
- 80 cm (115cm wide) strong fabric for outside,
 [curtain material is ideal, offcuts available from Chelfords,
 Coldharbour Lane, Harpenden]
- 80 cm (115 cm wide) fabric for inside, [curtain lining or cotton]
- thread to match fabric, sewing kit including **strong** hand sewing needle and thread, fabric scissors, pins, quilt clips.
- sewing machine with ¼" foot if possible, 2 machine needles size 90. [If you cannot bring your machine, there will be some available to use]





Book/gadget evening: bring a sewing book that you love or a useful gadget or one that you don't know how to use to share with fellow members.





* Colour magic for quilters, Icknield Quilters Sep 8th

- "A practical approach to making colour choices for your quilts. In the talk we will -
- look at examples of quilts where colours are chosen well (and less well!)
- investigate what we mean by colour words, and what others mean not always the same thing!
- discuss what we mean by "colour families"
- look at what criteria we can use to group fabrics by colour
- discuss useful resources for you

Unusually for a talk, I would like you to bring some (not necessarily all!) of these fabrics, about 3" or larger. One piece each of sky blue, sunshine yellow, tomato red, forest green, teal, peach and royal purple.
