If you would like to take part, please bring the following to make 2 crackers -

- 1 fat quarter each of Christmas fabric and plain contrasting fabric for the lining
- sewing kit and thread to match
- 1 metre of thin ribbon, Christmas trimmings (optional)
- card that can bend and hold a curve e.g. cereal packet cut into rectangles $[4 \text{ of } 2 \frac{3}{4}]^n \times 6 \frac{1}{2}$, $[2 \text{ of } 6 \frac{1}{2}]^n \times 4$, $[2 \text{ of } 6 \frac{1}{4}]^n \times 4$
- Pritt stick or fabric glue, rotary cutter mat and ruler, sewing kit


