In her talk she will give her personal history of quilt making, sharing what got her started as a young quilter and why she is still a passionate quilter more than 30 years on. She will bring a huge stack of quilts to show us too.</p> <p>Afternoon workshop: Borrowed from Boro: This is a modern interpretation of the traditional Japanese art of boro. The term was used to describe clothes and household items which were patched and repaired many times. While this was originally from necessity, their unique beauty is now widely recognised. Inspired by these utilitarian creations, students will use scraps of modern fabrics along with simple hand embroidery stitches in hand dyed threads to create individual, modern, patched works of art.</p> <p>It will be a great day, and so close to home!</p> <p>This event has been advertised nationally by Quilters Guild, there will be a limit on places, so don't miss out, book today! 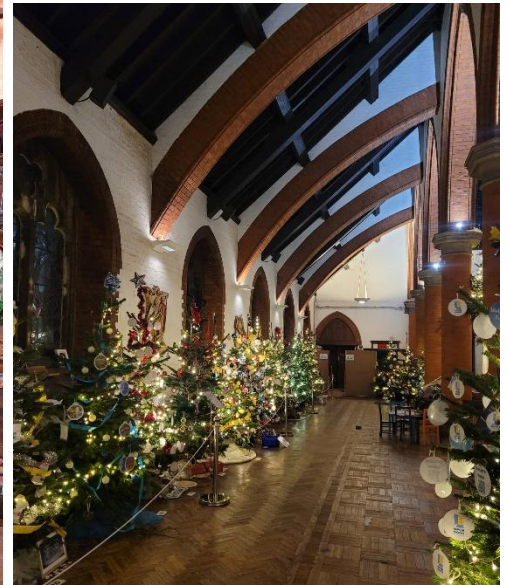
